## First 9 months 2007 Sales: + 12.3%

For the first 9 months ended September 2007, Group Crit sales amounted to 1 077,9 million euros showing an increase of 12.3%. In Q3 2007, growth increased by 8.1% with sales of 382.5 million euros

## Crit continues to outperform its market

**In Temp. Business segment** (88.4% of sales), Q3 sales reached 338.1 million euros, posting an increase of 9.6% (vs 3.8% in temp. market).

For the first 9 months 2007, sales amounted to 952.5 million euros, showing a growth of 14.6%.

The performance is particularly significant in France where the activity increased by 11.9% to 879.3 million euros for the first 9 months of the exercise. It should be noted that over the same period, the Temp. market in France grew by 7%.

International sales, which represents nearly 8% of total Temp. Business sales, amounted to 73.2 million euros for the first 9 months, posting an increase of 62%.

**In Multi-services segment**, Q3 activity was in line with target with sales amounting to 44.4 million euros vs 45.2 million euros in Q3 2006. This evolution does not take into account the new airport assistance contracts signed during last months which will give a boost to the growth in 2008.

In regards of these elements, the Group confirms its favourable outlooks as well in terms of growth as for increase in results.

Group Crit is one of the leaders in the temp. business in France. In addition to its core business, the group profits form a strong positioning in the sector of the Airport Assistance and from a business segment specialized in Engineering and Maintenance. Listed on compartment B of Eurolist Euronext Paris, Groupe Crit is part of indices CAC Mid&Small 190 and SBF 250.
